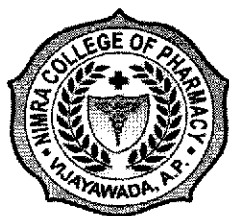

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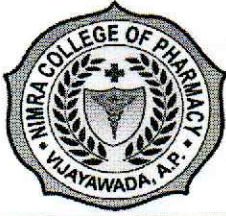

Such rules and guidelines often allow some flexibility, and the regulatory authorities expect companies to take responsibility for deciding how they should be interpreted. Rare diseases research requires a non-traditional skill set, including using a multidisciplinary team beyond physicians. As highlighted, owing to the wide geographic distribution of these patients, it helps to collaborate with multiple sites and be creative and innovative with study designs. Besides case reports and case series, other possibilities include meta-analysis, database mining, systematic reviews, and prospective longitudinal studies. The creation of a database at the local institution or via a collaborative process facilitates research in rare diseases, as does familiarity with processes such as orphan drug development. New investigators have extensive opportunities for research activities in rare diseases. Some unmet needs include the characterization of the natural history of rare diseases and conditions, identification of genotypic and phenotypic subpopulations, development.
