They are often derived from natural sources such as plants and may contain bioactive compounds such as antioxidants, polyphenols, and flavonoids. Nutraceuticals may be used to prevent or treat various health conditions, including cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and cancer.

Pelletization is a process used in the production of nutraceuticals and other pharmaceutical products. It involves forming small spherical pellets or granules from a mixture of active ingredients and excipients using a process called extrusion-spheronization.
